DIRECT SCHOOL ADMISSION FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS 2023 (DSA-SEC)

WHAT IS DSA-SEC?

Direct School Admission for secondary schools (DSA-Sec) allows students to apply to some schools before taking the PSLE.

Students apply based on their talent in sports, CCAs and specific academic areas.

If you are admitted to a secondary school through DSA-Sec, you are **not** allowed to:

- submit school choices during the Secondary 1 (\$1) posting process.
- transfer to another school. You must commit to your chosen school for the duration of the programme

WHO CAN APPLY?

Primary 6 students can apply for DSA-Sec based on a wide-range of talents, including:



Sports and games



Visual, literary and performing arts



Debate and public speaking



Science, mathematics and engineering



Languages and humanities



Uniformed groups



Leadership (for example, prefects)

ELIGIBILITY

Schools have different selection processes but, in general, applicants must be able to demonstrate their talent, potential, passion and character through their school track record and online DSA applications. For example:

- Represented the school in a CCA.
- Held a role in a play or performance.
- Done well in a subject such as mathematics or creative writing.
- Held a leadership role in class or a CCA.

OVERVIEW OF DSA-SEC PROCESS

1. Explore school choices

Schools offer different talent areas and each has its own selection process and schedule. Visit the schools' websites for more information.

2. Apply

Once you have explored and shortlisted the schools, submit your application online through the DSA-Sec Portal.

3. Attend interviews or auditions

Different schools have different selection processes. If shortlisted, you have to attend interviews and auditions conducted by DSA schools. Selected students will receive DSA-Sec offers from schools around September.

4. Select preferred schools

Choose up to 3 school choices in order of preference and submit/withdraw them using the DSA-Sec Portal around November.

5. Receive school allocation results

Receive school allocation along with PSLE results.
